Teacher Appreciation Week

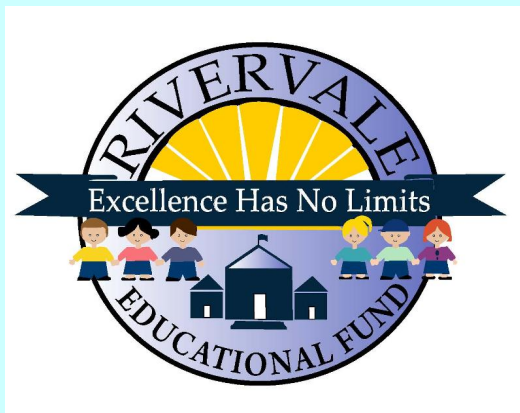

Air Conditioning

Earlier in the year, the Board of Education requested the district's administrative team conduct a study of our current capacity and use of air conditioning. The Board recognizes there are a variety of different opinions about this in the community, and certainly appreciated any feedback that was received. After thoughtful consideration, the district has decided at this time to maintain the current plan for air conditioning, which we have found to be successful, including running our chillers when appropriate on hot days in the gymnasiums, media centers, infill classrooms, specials rooms, and the cafeteria, and implementing the hot-weather instructional schedules developed by our principals, which provide a level of access to air conditioned spaces for students throughout the course of the day.
