Meeting opened to public comments at 7:04 P.M.

#### **Public comments:**

Ms. Diana Merida, 327 Perry Place: Ms. Merida respectfully requested that 1<sup>st</sup> grade next year be three sections not two sections. The current class size is 21 students for the two sections in Kindergarten. Ms. Merida spoke to the class size policy and stated that the Board has an opportunity to try a smaller class size. She also stated that the boy/girl ratio is very important.

Ms. Michele Ortiz, 546 Roosevelt Avenue: Ms. Ortiz stated that 150 minutes of health, safety and physical education (PE) is required per week, and wanted to know if we are following this. She also stated that other towns have more PE time and wanted to know if the District complies. PE is very important.

Mr. McCourt responded by stating that the district has been compliant in the way in which the state records PE minutes, inclusive of recess. However, he did note that changes may be coming relative to that based on the State's new recess legislation.

Mrs. Waldes responded by saying it is very frustrating with all the mandates coming down from the State.

Ms. Allison Franzese, 765 Westwood Avenue: Ms. Franzese wanted to know what is the rationale of going from three sections down to two sections like Kindergarten was.

Mr. McCourt explained that enrollment dictates how many sections there will be and that three sections were not cut down to two, but rather two sections were created as a result of the number of incoming kindergartners that year. He also stated that there was no decision made to change the number of sections prior to seeing enrollment for next year. He explained that the District

may gain or lose children over the summer. It is too early to determine the number of sections at this time; however, the District's class sizes are in alignment with the Board of Education's policy and regulations regarding class size.

Ms. Jaime Arlia, 195 Bergen Place: Ms. Arlia echoed the sentiments of wanting smaller class sizes. She stated that she would like to see three sections of 1<sup>st</sup> Grade for next year and that the District should take the opportunity to look at smaller class sizes.

Ms. Amy Ozarek, 252 Collignon Way: Ms. Ozarek wanted to know if the boy/girl ratio has an impact on student learning.

Mr. McCourt stated that the District is not aware of and does not have any student performance data to support any differences in learning based on boy/girl ratio. He also stated that ratio is important but typically not a rationale for the number of sections per grade, which is based on enrollment.

Ms. Teresa Klingele, 852 Berkshire Road: Ms. Klingele wanted to know if there will be inclass support if the District stays with two sections for next year's 1<sup>st</sup> Grade. She explained that smaller class size allows for the teacher to do more with the students. She also wanted to know how often does the in-class support teacher go into the current Kindergarten class.

Mr. McCourt stated that the in-class support model used this year in kindergarten would continue in first grade if the District maintained two sections. He also stated, however, that it is too premature to speak to next year's schedule without having finalized enrollment numbers. He also spoke about aides in the classroom and how accountability regulations will not allow for instructional aides for non-Special Education students.
